Organic wines are produced without the use of preservatives, fertilizers, industrial yeasts, and pesticides. Biodynamic wines go a step further: Biodynamic farms are supposed to be closed, self-sustaining systems. Biodynamics also sees the farm in the context of the wider pattern of lunar and cosmic rhythms. In this holistic view, the soil is seen not simply as a substrate for plant growth, but as an organism in its own right.
